Department of Fisheries is concentrating mainly on disposal of fishery rights of major tanks through lease & Tender-cum-Action process & also concentrating on development of tanks for fish production.

- Income generation - fish production will boost income generation.

## **Programmes & schemes of Department**

Fishery development programmers' are undertaken by Zilla Panchayath thorough state & district sector schemes.

### **Schemes of Department**

#### **Zilla Panchayath sector :**

1. Inland fisheries development .
2. Training & Exhibition.
3. Construction of fish farms .
4. Marketing assistance Mathsyavahini.

Special component plan & tribal sub plan through Taluk Panchayath to encourage SC/ST community people in fishery activity .

#### **State sector :**

1. Supply of fishery requisites to fisherman of General, SC/ST, OBC, Minorities etc.
2. Providing Life Jackets to fishermen of General, SC/ST, OBC, Minorities etc.
3. Supply of fiber glass coracles to fishermen General, SC/ST, OBC, Minorities etc.
4. Providing fish seed subsidy to fishermen of General, SC/ST, OBC, Minorities etc
5. Providing Ice box for marketing of fish to fisher women of General, SC/ST, OBC, and Minorities etc.

Under Matsyashraya scheme, houseless fishermen will be provided with subsidy to build houses.

### **Departmental Statistics at Glance**

The district has 388 major tanks, 1319 minor tanks besides 4 reservoirs for development of fishery activity. 30000 active fishermen are engaged in this activity harvesting 18-20 thousand metric tons of fish every year by fish seed stocking capacity of 200-220 lakhs fingerlings.
